What is a forensic Scientist?

- A scientist that helps police officers and special agents solve crimes
- Forensic scientists spend time in the area of the crime and in labs looking at the evidence to figure out what happened
- There are many types of forensic scientists. Some study people (psychology), some go to the scene of the crime with law enforcement for analysis, some look at a person's body, and some look at other types of physical evidence



What does a Forensic Scientist do?

- Looks at fingerprints, blood, bodies, tool marks, documents, and more that counts as evidence for a crime
- Takes pictures of crime scenes
- Goes to the lab to analyze evidence and writes lab reports
- Talks to a jury in court to explain what happened during a crime



Does a Forensic Scientist need to go to school?

- Forensic Scientists normally go to college and beyond!
- Some go to medical school, law school, and pharmacy school
