BUS ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE ZONE

Number of Volunteers: 2

Location:

1. Curb in front of Convention Center entrance – two volunteers

Role Description

- AM Arrivals:
 - Direct buses to drop off zone at curb
 - Ensure they line up single file
 - Ensure they are not letting kids out until they reach the drop off zone and have been directed by staff to unload
 - Direct attendees toward entrance
 - Direct buses with DROP OFF & RETURN signs to exit convention center
 - Direct buses with PARK & WAIT signs toward bus parking area
- PM Departures:
 - Direct buses to pick up zone at curb
 - Ensure they line up single file
 - \circ $\;$ Ensure they are not picking up kids until they reach the drop off zone
 - Direct attendees to board buses

X-STEM AMBASSADORS/GREETER

Number of Volunteers: 4

Location:

- 1. Conv Ctr Entrance/Check in area one volunteer
- 2. Top of escalators one volunteer
- 3. In Hallway of Workshop Rooms 8, 9, 10 one volunteer
- 4. In Hallway of Workshop Rooms 14A, 14B, 15A, 15B, 16A, 16B one volunteer

Role Description

- Warmly greet all visitors
- Direct attendees to restrooms, exits, event rooms, and transportation as needed
- Be familiar with the workshop room layouts
- Float in area to assist guests
- Be familiar with lost child plan and assist as needed
- Assist with other special projects as requested
- Provide information in a cheerful, friendly manner

X-STEM WORKSHOP ROOM FLOATER

Number of Volunteers: 2

Location:

- 1. Workshop Rooms 8, 9, 10 one volunteer
- 2. Workshop Rooms 14A, 14B, 15A, 15B, 16A, 16B one volunteer

Role Description

- Work with workshop presenters on any troubleshooting as needed
- Locate assistance from A/V or other staff as needed
- Be familiar with workshop room layouts

LUNCH AREA MANAGEMENT

Number of Volunteers: 2

Location: path from workshops to lunch lunch area

Role Description

- (2) people to block exit toward the left side of the terrace and the escalator/stairs down to the Mezzanine and direct attendees to the West Terrace via the right side exit (see map)
- Directing attendees from workshop areas to lunch area, and vice versa
- Float around lunch area
- Alert attendees when time to return
- Ensure trash is thrown away by students
